

A new era in imaging

Says Kris Giordano, Imaging Manager, "Having a system that delivers on the speed and doesn't sacrifice resolution, doesn't compromise image quality (which was always the tradeoff in MR), we've entered this other era of imaging."

Being able to increase time slots for fast, highquality exams meets the needs of referring physicians and their patients. "We have to be able to accommodate patients without booking out two weeks in advance. Because it you have to book out two weeks in advance, you'll lose those patients," he notes. "From our standpoint, logistically we had to be able to accommodate them. We've been able to transition into primarily 30-minute time slots."
